The Pledge of Allegiance was said by those attending.

**Secretary** Minutes from the May meeting were approved as printed in the June Clubber.

**Treasurer's Report** Copies of this report were distributed and are on file. For a copy of this report, call Michael Bell at 410-526-5826. Motion was made and seconded to accept the report.

### Committee Reports

**Clubber ( NEW CLUBBER DEADLINE )** To make for a smoother process in assembling the Clubber, beginning August 8th, **the deadline for submitting articles to the Clubber will be changed from the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month to the 8<sup>th</sup>.** August 8, 2008 will be the first new deadline date and apply to the September issue.

**Membership** Membership drive will end July 31st. There are 265 members for 2008 to date. Postcards sent to residents that have not yet joined have been very effective. The Treasurer will continue to send these out. There was discussion of next year having all members be eligible for prizes (e.g. gift cards, etc.). Discussion to follow at future CCECA meetings.

Timber Grove Community held a meeting recently about the East Cherry Hill extension. It is scheduled to begin in 2010 and be completed in 2012.

It appears that they may be opposing the Extension.

Reisterstown Shopping Center has asked for a zoning change to reduce parking places for a possible fast food restaurant and/or bank. WaWa has filed an appeal and a hearing will be held in July.

Kevin Kamenetz will be holding hearings regarding zoning information. There will be one at the Reisterstown library on 7/30/08 from 6-8 p.m.

**Civic Affairs** Bushes and trees over sidewalks are a problem and safety hazard for our children as well as adults. Residents are responsible for keeping them trimmed. Baltimore County will be doing a sweep of our community in the near future and this may be an issue they will be on the lookout for in our neighborhood.

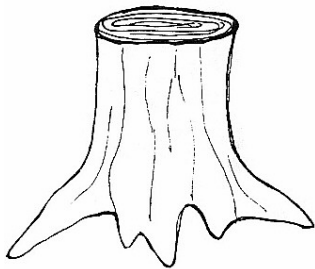
