STANDING RULES

- 1) Hospitality and Flowers are ongoing committees, which by virtue of the definition used by this Association, do not qualify as Standing Committees; and, therefore, are not members of the Board of Governors. These persons are not required to attend meetings and, in the event they do attend, would not have a vote by reason of representing the aforementioned committees. (Constitution: Article IV, Section 5).
- 2) During election of President, Vice President, treasurer, and Representatives-at-Large, where the candidate runs unopposed, the Secretary shall cast one vote for the nominee, officially electing that person to the position. (Constitution: Article IV, Section 7).
- 3) Absentee Ballots shall not be used in the election process. Each household in good standing, who are present at the meeting, may cast a ballot.
- 4) In the event of a vacancy in the positions of Vice President or Treasurer, the Board of Governors shall elect a replacement to serve the unexpired term. (Constitution: Article IV, section 3).
- 5) During monthly meetings, all adult members in good standing may present a motion regarding any community business and may participate in the discussion, but only members of the Board of Governors or their alternates shall be eligible to vote on the question.
- 6) The maximum donation shall be \$50.00, once a year, per organization, unless special considerations apply.
- 7) Requests from non-profit organizations for donations should be made in writing, except for schools in our community.
- 8) Although not specifically stated in the By-Laws, the secretary and treasurer shall be voting members of the Board of Governors. (By-Laws: Article II, Sections 4 and 6).
- 9) When multi-members of one family occupy positions on the executive committee, only one of them shall be authorized to sign Association checks. (By-Laws: Article II, Section 5).
